LICENSING AND PARTICIPATION

- All USA Cycling rules and regulations apply.
- Races held rain or shine.
- No aero bars in the criterium or road race.
- US DOT, CPSC, or other approved helmets required for all races, including warm up and cool down.
- One-day and annual license applications will be available at registration.
- Results for the weekend provided by Topview Sports Event Services. Results will be posted at Jumbotron trailer following the finish of race after USA Cycling officials approve race results. Race Result Active Pro timing chips will be used and are mandatory for all Amateur events. USA CRITS Pro events will use My LAPS CHIPS provided by Swagger Events Services. Riders that do not own a timing chip will need to rent one onsite. Rental fee is \$10 for the weekend. A credit card swipe will be required as collateral for the rental by Topview Sports or Swagger Events.
- Route Mechanical Support services will be available onsite to include flat repair, basic mechanical assistance in the wheelpit on the criterium course. Sunday's Choccolocco Road Race Course will have wheel trucks following each wave and minimal mechanical support services offered onsite. All equipment borrowed for race use, wheels, etc. must be returned immediately following the finish of the race.

SATURDAY On-Site Registration, operational schedule:

Registration opens @ 7:00 a.m.CST inside the Classic on Noble restaurant – please arrive a minimum of 30min before your race starts. Registration closes 20 minutes before each race.

SUNDAY On-Site Registration, operational schedule:

Registration opens @ 6:00 a.m.CST (location TBD) – please arrive a minimum of 30min before your race starts. Registration closes 20 minutes before each race.

NOTE: RACERS WILL HAVE THE SAME RACE NUMBER FOR THE ENTIRE WEEKEND IF REGISTERED FOR ALL 3 EVENTS.

NOTE: FOR THE SUNNY KING CRITERIUM ONLY – AN ATHLETE CAN REGISTER FOR A SECOND RACE FOR \$25.

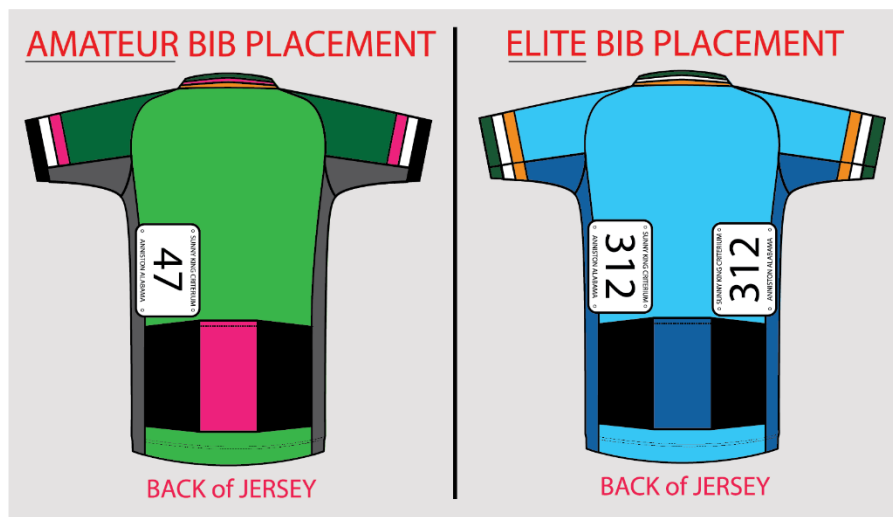

TIMING, SCORING AND RESULTS

Timing and scoring will be done using a computer program by our timing staff. In addition to the staff and computer program, a high-speed camera will also be present at the finish line. The timing equipment and staff will be located in the officials' tent on a custom raised platform immediately adjacent to the finish line and truss.

Results will be posted on the Results Board located on Noble Street by the Finish Truss. Results will also be posted on the race website at <https://www.annistoncycling.com/sunny-king-criterium/>.

Results for the weekend provided by Topview Sports Event Services. Results will be posted at the Jumbotron trailer following the finish of race after USA Cycling officials approve race results.

Race Result Active Pro timing chips will be used and are mandatory for all Amateur events.

Chip timing for the USA CRITS Professional Races will also be used for livestream & live timing for the broadcast.

USA CRITS Pro events will use My LAPS CHIPS provided by Swagger Events Services. Riders that do not own a timing chip will need to rent one onsite. Rental fee is \$10 for the weekend. A credit card swipe will be required as collateral for the rental by Topview Sports or Swagger Events.

TIMING CHIP RETURN:

After your races are completed for the weekend, return your timing chip to REGISTRATION (there are 2 wooden boxes for chip return). NOTE, if you are only doing the Criterium, please return the chip to REGISTRATION at the Classic on Noble Restaurant. For both days of events, Dayna Molyneaux in the Reg Coordinator for chip return.

If you are a regular "chip forgetter" Please buy your own chip and never take it off your bike so you don't have to ever rent again. [BUY YOUR OWN NEW CHIP HERE...](#)

If you forget to return your timing chip at the end of the event you MUST mail your timing chip back.

You MUST mail your timing chip back IN A PADDED ENVELOPE or box to:

If you attempt to return a chip in a standard business envelope with paper wrapped around it, the post office will process the envelope as a flat item and the chip will be pushed out the end of the envelope and we will receive an empty envelope. An empty envelope is a lost chip and you will be charged \$100 for us to replace the chip with Race Result.

1. The onsite rental fee is a charge not a deposit. This is why and how we encourage riders to own their own chips.
2. Topview Sports leases the chips from Race Result.
3. No, you can't keep the rental chip you forgot to return and just pay the difference as the chips are leased. Additionally, the chips are rentals that have been used a bunch and have less battery than a nice new one would.
4. We will scan the chips on the day after each event to determine the non-returned chips. Once we identify the names of the riders who used those chips they will be notified via email, phone, text, FB Message, smoke signals etc. Upon contact the rider will have 7 days to return the chip to Topview Sports offices.
5. If the chip does not arrive in 7 days from contact, then the rider's credit card that was left on file as collateral for the rental will be charged \$200.
6. If you lost the chip and it can't be returned you will be refunded \$100.
7. When the timing chip is finally returned the riders card will be refunded for \$175. The \$25 charge covers hassle, costs and time involved in numbers 1-5 above.
8. No, you cannot bring the chip to the next race. We need them back in office before the next race so please be proactive and mail them back as instructed above.

RACE NUMBERS

Bib numbers will be available at registration the morning of each day of racing.

PLEASE NOTE: Racers should keep their number all weekend and not expect different numbers per day through registration.

START ORDER

Amateur races:

The start staging area is located before the finish straight. Riders are advised to be in the vicinity of the Start Staging Area at least 15 minutes prior to race start time.

Rider call-ups/start grid position will be done **for pre-registered riders only** based on USAC standings. The first row of riders will be those who are listed in the USAC standings and present at the race, all subsequent rows will be filled in succession. If riders are not present with 10 minutes to start and miss their call-up, they will lose their start grid position. Concerns about start order should be addressed with the Registrar no less than 30 minutes before the start of the respective event. Riders registering day of will fill in behind.

Elite races:

The start staging area is located before the finish straight. Riders are advised to be in the vicinity of the Start Staging Area at least 15 minutes prior to race start time.

Rider call-ups/start grid position will be done **for pre-registered riders only** based on USAC standings. The first row of riders will be those who are listed in the USAC standings and present at the race, all subsequent rows will be filled in succession. If riders are not present with 10 minutes to start and miss their call-up, they will lose their start grid position. Concerns about start order should be addressed with the Registrar no less than 30 minutes before the start of the respective event. Riders registering day of will fill in behind.



PIT REQUIREMENTS AND NEUTRAL SUPPORT

Each rider is allowed two mechanics and one paramedical assistant. Each rider will be issued up to 3 pit passes with their corresponding rider numbers at sign-in. No other personnel shall be allowed in the Pit Zone. Anyone receiving a pit pass must show a USAC/UCI license and have it recorded with the number of the rider(s) they are supporting. (NOTE: any valid USAC/UCI license is acceptable, except one-day licenses)

Race staff will provide pit pass badges prior to packet pick up at sign-in. All credentials MUST be picked up 1 hour prior to the start of the race. Race staff and officials will check for credentials in the pit and any individual found without proper credentials will be asked to leave the pit area.

Neutral Support will be available for all riders in the pit area for both days. A USAC certified mechanic will be available.

LAPPED RIDERS

Please be courteous and move to the side when being lapped, do not contest or interfere. The Chief Referee can and will pull lapped riders, but it is our intent to allow all riders to finish each event. For the Men's and Women's Elite events, the 80% rule may be applied at USAC discretion.

Early bell option for USAC races:

- Lapped riders will be left in the race but are not to interfere with the leaders on course.
- The lap cards will change to 1 lap-to-go based on (the scheduled time of the race)-(the average lap time X 1.3).
- Some riders may see the cards change from 3-to-go to 1-to-go and will get the bell before the leaders on the course.
- Riders caught by riders who got the bell will finish when the lap cards display 0 laps-to-go.
- Riders are placed by time if on the same lap as the leaders, or "@ Laps Incomplete" if they do not complete the full race distance.
- Riders abandoning will be listed as DNF in the results.



EVENT MEDICAL STAFF

Local ambulance services and the county sheriff have been informed of the event. An ambulance will be on standby on Noble Street and 11th for the treatment of minor injuries for athletes, staff and spectators. First aid will be available in the Medical area located within the EVENT HQ. At least one doctor and 2 trained first aid providers will be on course.

HOSPITALS

Regional Medical Center (RMC) 400 E 10th St, Anniston, AL 36207 (.5 miles / 2 minutes from race course) 256-235-5121

RMC is a Level III Trauma Center staffed 24/7 with qualified ED physicians. The ED is supported with 24/7 coverage of several specialists including General Surgery, Orthopedics, and Neurology. The ED is in close proximity to CT scan to rapidly evaluate and diagnose head injuries as well as other traumatic injuries.

The ED does have protocols in place to rapidly transfer, after stabilization, patients who may require Level I Trauma Services or Neurosurgery.

POLICING AND SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS

County sheriff deputies and have been notified and will be available throughout the event.

There will be a minimum of 3 crosswalks on the course and these will be manned by course marshals on both sides of the criterium course throughout the event.

Security personnel will be located at the beer garden/food court under the large pavilion by the finish line.

ANTI-DOPING



U.S. Anti-Doping Agency

The **Sunny King Criterium, Choccolocco Road Race** are subject to USADA anti-doping Examination Regulations and all competitors and team personnel must abide by these regulations. Any riders with a nonnegative test result (following any adjudication process) will forfeit any prizes won at the event.

Anti-doping control will be on the 3rd floor of the Classic on Noble located above registration. The list of riders required to report will be posted on the Results board prior to the finish of the race. The racers will be required to report to anti-doping control within 30 minutes after the finish of the event.

It is the responsibility of the rider and/or his/her team personnel to ensure that he/she reports to anti-doping within the required time.

PODIUM ETIQUETTE & AWARDS CEREMONY PROTOCOL

The riders that must report to the podium are the Race Winner, 2nd and 3rd place.

All podium finishers **must wear his/her race/team kit for podium pictures. *This is your opportunity to support your sponsors and the event sponsors!***

Prize money may be withheld from a rider who does not report for the podium ceremony. It is the rider's responsibility to be present for the awards presentation.

- Elite awards podium ceremonies will be held immediately, but no later than 15 minutes, after the finish of each race on both days.
- Amateur awards podium ceremonies will be held approximately 15 minutes after the completion of each race on both days.
