GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Each USA CRITS event is USA Cycling sanctioned and the series shall abide by the general rules and regulations outlined by USA Cycling.
- **Events are open to ALL Men's Pro/1/2 and Women's Pro/1/2/3 racers**, unless otherwise indicated. **All events have supporting races.** Please consult the race flyers in this Tech Guide and each event's webpage for details. Noted. You are not required to be part of a D1 TEAM to compete or qualify for the daily prize purses and the Individual Overall Prize Purse.
- View each event's individual race flyer and website for official start times, payout, registration, and other event information
- USA CRITS & Pro Elite races are limited to 6 riders per team
- D1 TEAMS may be Trade, Club or Composite
- D1 TEAMS must submit their final race day rosters a min of 14 days in advance of each event
- All riders competing must be part of the original registration list. No mid series changes are allowed
- USA CRITS Travel Stipends are available to pre-registered D1 TEAMS competing in the USA CRITS series
- D1 TEAM bonus payments are made to team management & a w9 is required
- Each PRO rider will be assigned a transponder. A credit card will be required as a form of collateral. Unreturned transponders will incur a \$100 fee

The 2026 USA CRITS events have a stand-alone Rider Prize Purse totaling

\$44,000 for Women and \$44,000 for Men

Returning for 2026: Open Individual Overall Prize Purse (Awarded after Winston-Salem)

\$5,000 for Women (10 places deep) and \$5,000 for Men (10 places deep)

D1 TEAM Overall Competition Prize Purse (Awarded after Winston-Salem)

\$10,000 for Women (10 places deep) and \$10,000 for Men (10 places deep)

D1 TEAM Travel Fund Stipends Available

\$6,450 per team, paid in five installments throughout the season (Paid on the Fridays that fall after Anniston, LaGrange, Suwanee, Rock Hill, and Winston-Salem. (Details on flowing pages)

REGISTRATION

- Limited to 15 Women's & 15 Men's D1 TEAMS
- Registered Composite D1 TEAMS are invited and assistance in the formation of a composite D1 TEAM is available
- All riders must have current USAC or UCI numbers to be entered. A password will be given to all interested teams.

BENEFITS AND ELIGIBILITY

- Includes entries for up to six (6) riders to all 8 USA CRITS + 2 supporting events, Rock Hill & Winston-Salem (10 races plus Wahoo Races on the Stage in Athens)
- Individual race entries are projected to be \$65 in advance online and \$75 on the day of each race
- Eligible for each event's day-of prize purses
- Eligible for Open Individual Overall points accumulation (points are gained across all USA CRITS events evenly)
- Eligible for Open Individual Overall Prize Purse - Awarded after Winston-Salem
- Eligible for D1 TEAM Overall Competition Prize Purse -Awarded after Winston-Salem
- D1 TEAM Overall Competition points are awarded to the top four (4) D1 TEAM finishers from each race throughout (8 series races)
- A minimum of four (4) riders and a maximum of six (6) riders must be registered per race and compete to receive D1 TEAM Overall Competition points

- D1 TEAM roster can vary from event to event
- Eligible for D1 TEAM travel stipends
- Each D1 TEAM is guaranteed one (1) callup per event
- Eligible for race-day rider intros based on series overall standings

Preferred allocation of host and hotel accommodation as available per event. D1

TEAMS requesting housing support (**where available/not guaranteed**) must submit requests that include arrival/departure info and number of athletes/managers traveling **a minimum of 21 days in advance** of each race

- Preferred allocation of food vouchers at participating restaurants per event (where available)

ASSET PRODUCTION & DELIVERY

- D1 TEAMS are highlighted on USA CRITS website, social media accounts, and livestream shows
- D1 TEAMS video short will be produced by USA CRITS, made available to D1 TEAMS, and will be shown on live stream shows throughout the 2026 season and in various series promotional pieces
- D1 TEAM access to Official USA CRITS photographer's images for social media use (individual agreements made between photographer and each D1 TEAM will be facilitated by USA CRITS)
- Reserved area in D1 TEAM Zone at events with available space (10x10 course side space or branded vehicle space)

STIPULATIONS

- Both D1 TEAMS and Composite D1 TEAMS may consist of six (6) riders (with a minimum of four (4) and a maximum of six (6) riders competing per event)
- Team Managers directly register teams/riders and update rosters with substitutions **up to 4 days** before each race
- A minimum number of team members that can be put on the team roster; However, they must be exclusive to the team and cannot enter individually (if already on a registered D1 TEAM).

USA CRITS Tech Guide will be produced and made available online with all pertinent information including points tables, prize purse payouts, and more.

D1 TEAM TRAVEL STIPENDS | Total per D1 TEAM = \$6,450

- A minimum of four (4) riders and a maximum of six (6) riders per D1 TEAM in attendance is required for travel stipend disbursements.
- D1 TEAMS must participate in all races within a payment period to receive travel stipends -- please refer to the chart below to see how race locations are distributed through each disbursement period.
- D1 TEAM managers/assigned representatives will receive travel stipend disbursements the week following Anniston, LaGrange, Suwanee, Rock Hill, and Winston-Salem. Stipends are issued via bank transfer to the manager or official delegate of each D1 TEAM.

- Stipend #1 - \$650 - Races included: Anniston
- Stipend #2 - \$2,300 - Races included: The Global Challenge, Athens, LaGrange
- Stipend #3 - \$1,950 - Races included: Greenville, Spartanburg, Suwanee
- Stipend #4 - \$650 - Races included: Rock Hill Weekend
- Stipend #5 - \$900 - Races included: Winston-Salem Weekend

D1 TEAMS – Qualify for D1 TEAM Bonus Fund

- Top 4 riders combined points from the above for overall placement
- D1 TEAMS and Individual riders accumulate **combined points in USA CRITS designated races.**
- In the event of a tie in any of the points competitions, the method of breaking the tie is as follows:
 - Most amount of 1st place finishes
 - Most amount of 2nd place finishes
 - Most amount of 3rd place finishes
 - The finish order in the most recent event

CASH PRIMES

- Are given throughout each race totaling \$1,000 each for all Pro Women & Men (included in advertised daily prize purse totals)

PRO RACE COMPETITIONS

- USA CRITS will award daily winner's jerseys and the conclusion of each race
- Individual leaders of the USA CRIT series will receive jerseys before the start of each race starting after the Sunny King Criterium
- All series leaders MUST wear the official series Leader's Jersey in all races. Failure to do so will result in – 1st Offence: Deduction of 200 Series Points and a \$200 fine. 2nd Offense: Disqualification from series.
- The Overall USA CRITS series winner's jerseys will be presented at the conclusion of racing in Winston-Salem on May 23, 2026.
- NOTE: Jersey awards eligibility is for ALL Pro riders competing in the USA CRITS series.

Series – Long TEAM Overall

- D1 TEAM standings are calculated for D1 TEAMS only. Standings will be updated after each race and are awarded to the top 10 D1 TEAMS after the USA CRITS finals in Winston-Salem
- TEAM points and awards are determined by the sum total of the top 4 riders of each team per race. Total points earned along with those earned in races will go toward the D1 TEAM bonus prize purse
- D1 TEAMS must start with a minimum of 4 riders in any given race to accumulate TEAM points

RIDER INTRODUCTIONS

- Staging is 100 meters before the start line
- Riders are not allowed to enter staging/callups from opposite course direction
- Individual leaders in overall series standings receive call ups
- Top 3 riders overall in series receive call ups
- Previous year's event winners receive call ups
- One rider from each pre-registered D1 TEAM receives call ups
- Additional riders at the discretion of event promoters (2 maximum) receive call ups
- Team Managers will receive an SMS message early each day with Callup List
- Each day's callups along with staging info will be posted at registration/number pickup
- Callups are coordinated with the livestream broadcast. For the purpose of the live stream and graphics, please be on time/ in position and come forward lining up from RIGHT to LEFT at start line
- Note: Series Leaders must wear leaders' jerseys in each race

PODIUMS

- Pro Women's and Pro Men's podiums will be **held after the conclusion of the men's race** and take place after the 15 minute protest period has expired
- Podiums for the top 3 finishers in each race
- Each Pro race winner will receive a special Winners Jersey
- Please make your way to the awards area immediately after the conclusion of the pro men's race
- *Series leader's jerseys will be given out before the start of the next USA CRITS event.

NEUTRAL SUPPORT

- Provided at all USA CRITS races by Swagger NRS unless otherwise noted
- Please consult each venue's website, flyer and course map for locations

MEDICAL CONTROL

- USA CRITS is subject to USADA Anti-Doping Examination. All competitors and team personnel must abide by these regulations
- Any rider found positive will forfeit all points and prizes won during the event and series.
- The list of riders required to report will be posted at the start/finish stage. The riders will be required to report to medical control immediately after the awards and protocol ceremonies.

LIVE STREAMING

All USA CRITS and Speed Week events will be live streamed on **OUTSIDE tv** starting with the Sunny King Criterium and ending with the USA CRITS Finals at the Winston-Salem Cycling Classic and will be **free** to view.
